Mixed Media in Painting and Collage

A \$40 supply fee will be due to the instructor on the first day of class

Supplies to bring:

3 canvases or canvas boards, 11" x 14" or larger

2 pieces of watercolor paper, a few sheets of handmade papers (rice papers), and a few pieces of unstretched unprimed canvas, 8 ½" x 11".

You may choose to bring additional surfaces to paint on as well.

A variety of synthetic brushes; flats, rounds and filberts in different sizes. I will have some to share, but you need to have your favorites. Make sure you have at least one that is at least 1 inch or larger.

Palette knives (a variety of sizes), scissors, and a straight edge.

A variety of drawing materials, such as pencils, oil pastels, caran d'arche crayons and/or watercolor pencils. No chalk pastels, please.

Paper or glass palettes. Grease resistant paper plates work well and can be cut up and used for collage in your work!

Rags or paper towels.

Terry cloth towel, small bath size.

Painted surfaces (paper, fabric, canvas, etc.) you can cut up and collage into your images. Old paintings work well for this.

Any type of paper for collage. Hand made papers or rice paper scraps work well.

Stencils if you have any, otherwise you can use mine.

Black and white laser copy images (NOT inkjet) of photos, drawings, or other images. If you wish to try to direct transfer, be sure to reverse the image when photocopying. I will have some copies for you to learn the process.

Heavy plastic stretched over a rigid surface. (You can use a heavy weight plastic bag and tape it down on the back side of a board or heavy cardboard)

Images to work from and a desire to have a lot of fun!
