Below is a list of supplies I would recommend for the upcoming workshop. While these supplies are not required, I find it helpful to keep most of these items with me when painting and drawing outdoors. Bring 8-10 small canvases, panels, or other support or paper such as. 6"X 8", 10"x12", 12"x16" or similar sizes. (No toned or under painted ones please.)

**Outdoor Painting & Drawing Supplies**

- Paint and extra tubes esp. white. I suggest the following: Titanium white, a Medium red, Ultramarine blue, Cobalt blue (optional), Cadmium yellow, Yellow ochre (optional) and Burnt sienna (optional). Feel free to bring other colors if you wish.
- Walnut alkyd medium for oil painting (what I use) or other medium of your choice
- Water for those working in water mediums
- If using other painting and drawing mediums, bring enough to get you through the day please.
- Backpack or case/big bag to carry art gear
- Paint box/pochade/ big board- something to hold your panels/paper, etc as you work
- ***Sketch book and pencil- very important***
- Vine stick charcoal
- Masking tape
- Paper towels
- Palette knife for mixing paint or a spoon or knife will work, too
- Trash bags
- Bug spray
- Sun block
- Camera
- ***Water for drinking-very important***
- A folding chair/camp stool
- Hat with a wide brim
- Storage/transport containers for paintings- to take artwork home
- Coat/jacket/sweatshirt/long sleeve shirt
- Rain gear
- Field/ wind pants (optional)
- Extra pair of shoes if your one pair gets wet
- Tylenol, Advil, or any other medication you may want

We will meet shortly before 9AM at the Peninsula Art School in Fish Creek the first day of class. Please feel free to contact PAS for further information or to answer any questions you have about the workshop.
