Required

- Photographic equipment: camera(s), a sturdy tripod*, shutter release cable/remote, film and/or digital storage cards, back-up batteries, lens cloth/chamois, camera strap and camera manual. All your equipment should be portable and in a knapsack, shoulder bag or tote.
- Additional equipment: A notebook for recording image making/journal, sunscreen/hat, bug repellent, water, a small amount of cash to have lunch, grab a coffee/tea, an ice cream or pay a small entrance fee.
- Optional equipment: laptops for those using digital in the classroom and a WI State Park sticker on your vehicle.
- Complete knowledge of your personal equipment is required. Please arrive with the knowledge of how to turn off your flash. If a cable release does not screw into your shutter release button, please have studied your manual to set your timer function or set your remote control.
- Car-pooling will be necessary to visit the numerous locations. I can fit 3 to 4 students & their equipment comfortably in my SUV (that also has a current WI State Park sticker.)
- Please be prepared to share with the class your finest examples of recent work on the first day of class: either actual print(s) or a "ready-to-go" digital image presentation on a personal laptop. Please limit your presentation to 5 to 10 images. This will allow me to immediately get to know you photographically.
- I have an extensive itinerary already set for our three days. But if you're interested in having the workshop explore a particular site I haven't included, please feel free to share your desires and I will do my best to squeeze it in.
- If you should have any questions or concerns please do not hesitate to contact me directly – email is always best but a call is just fine, too.

I look forward to spending time together photographing the sublime beauty of Door County.
