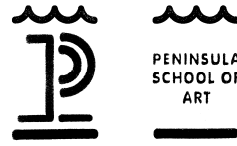

- A Digital camera, preferably an SLR. It must have the capability to be set either manually or have an Aperture priority mode and be able to manually focus.
- Charged batteries and cleared memory cards.
- A laptop computer of their own that is in good working condition and plenty of open hard drive space. 10gb or more.
- A memory card reader or cord to transfer images from camera to computer.
- A tripod
- Software which can be the 30 day trial versions, but this will leave a watermark on final images. These should be downloaded the day prior to class unless we have internet connection at the class and we can do it then.
